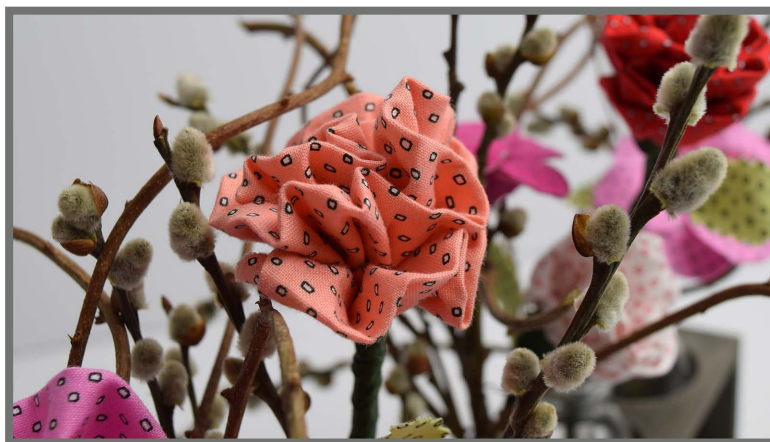

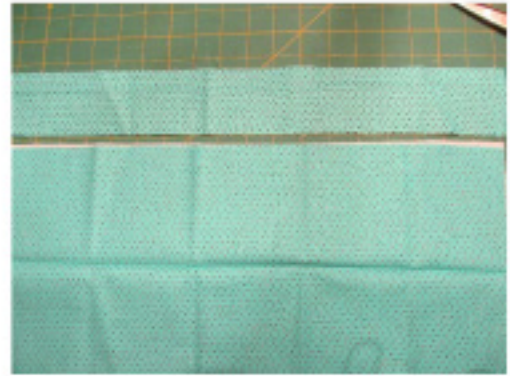

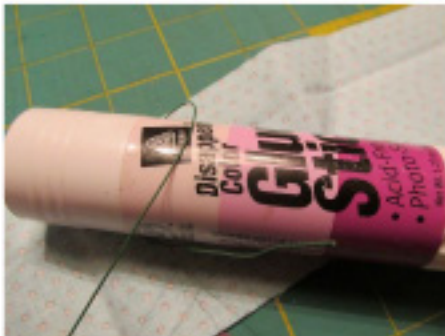

Fabric Flower Supplies:

- Fat Quarters
- Wire
- Spray adhesive
- Glue
- Floral Tape
- Sticks
- Dowel / anything round to form petals



Step 1:
Cut one 2 1/2" X 22" strip of fabric



Step 2:
Using the dowel (in my case glue stick) loop the wire and twist to secure...leave about 2" space in between each loop (petal), make five (See Diagram A)

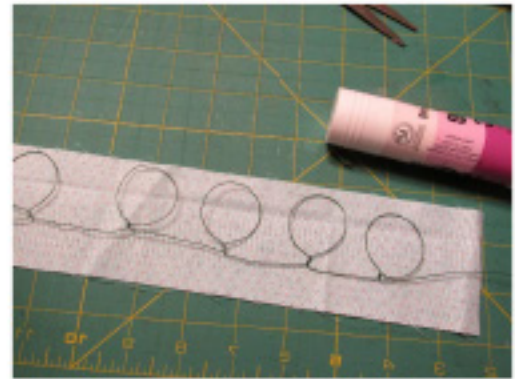
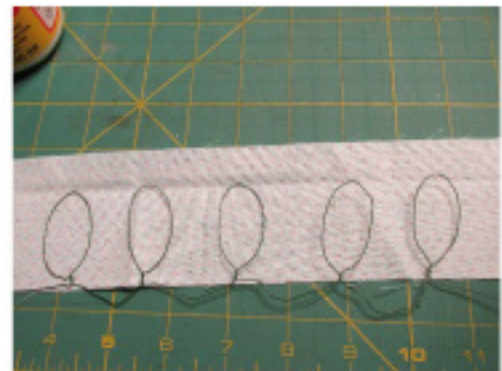


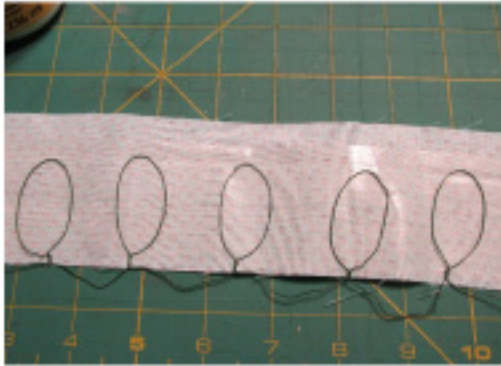

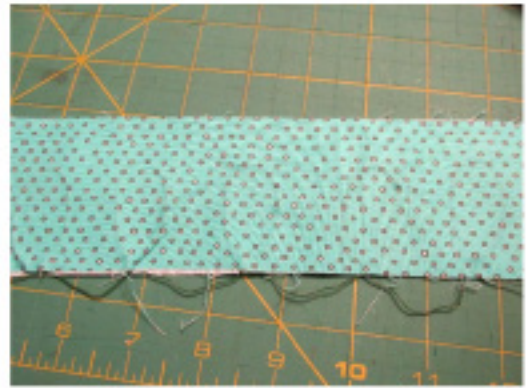
Step 3:
Lay loops flat on 1/2 of strip (pulling wire down in between each loop)



Step 4:
Pull up slightly on each loop to form petal



Step 5:
Spray adhesive strip and lay wire petals on top



Step 6:
Fold strip in half covering wire petals



Step 7:
Cut in between each petal



Step 8:
Cut each petal using wire outline as a guide



Step 9:
Gather petals, stacking one on top of the other



Step 10:
Secure by twisting wire around base of petals



Step 11:
Using the remain wire, wrap around stick to secure flower



Step 12:
Wrap base of flower and stick with floral tape



Step 13:
Cut one 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square, using scraps place in center of square, gather four corners (See Diagram B)

Step 14:
Secure by twisting wire tightly forming a ball, trip excess wire and fabric (See Diagram C)

Step 15:
Drop glue in center of flower and add center (See Diagram D)

Fabric Flower Supplies:

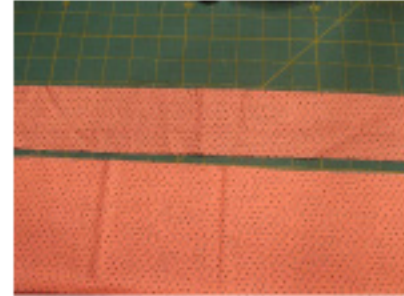
Fat Quarters
Floral Tape
Wire



Step 2:
Cut one piece of wire 22"



Step 4:
Use wire and straight stitch
length of strip using 1/4" stitches



Step 1:
Cut one strip 2 1/2" x 22"



Step 3:
Fold strip in half widthwise



Step 5:
Gather fabric towards center
leaving tails of wire on each end
(Diagram A)

Step 6:
Tuck one end of fabric into itself to hide selvage & fold 1/4"



Step 7:
Twist / roll the remaining fabric to form your rose



Step 8:
Tuck end into itself to hide selvage



Step 9:
Take one tail of wire and wrap securely around base of rose (Diagram B)

Step 10:
Wrap and twist wire around stick to secure (Diagram C)



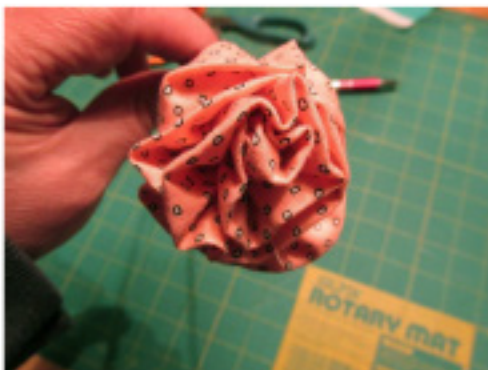

Step 11:
Using floral tape, wrap base of rose and stick / stem (Diagram D)
