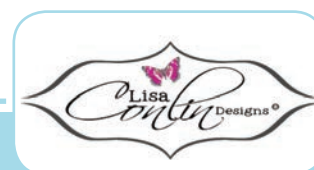

### Cutting Directions:

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (perpendicular to selvages) unless noted otherwise.

WOF = Width of fabric from selva to selva.

#### A. 24488-EJ: Christmas Blocks – Black

- Fussy cut twelve 11 1/2" blocks.

#### B. 24492-E: Poinsettia – Cream

- Cut two 11 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.
- Cut two 15 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" strips.

#### C. 24490-E: Large Poinsettia & Holly – Cream

- Cut three 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into ten 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and four 4 1/2" squares.
- Cut two 8 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into six 8 1/2" squares.

#### D. 24491-E: Holly – Cream

- Cut four 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make ninety-six triangles.

#### E. 24492-R: Poinsettia – Red

- Cut four 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into twenty-four 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make ninety-six triangles.
- Cut eight 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### F. 24492-F: Poinsettia – Green

- Cut seven 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into forty-eight 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (192) triangles.

#### G. 24491-F: Holly – Green

- Cut three 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fourteen 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- Cut five 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventeen 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### Backing 24489-F: Small Poinsettia & Holly – Green

- Cut two 96" x WOF strips. Sew together and trim to make one 74" x 96" back.

### Block Assembly:

1. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of one  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A block. Sew one  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make one A block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make twelve A blocks total.

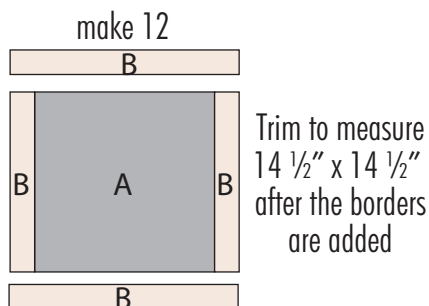

2. Sew one Fabric D triangle, one Fabric E triangle and two Fabric F triangles together to make one F block (Fig. 2). Repeat to make ninety-six F blocks total.

3. Sew one F block to each end of one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to make one sashing block (Fig. 3).

4. Sew two F blocks together to make one side strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make thirty-four side strips total.

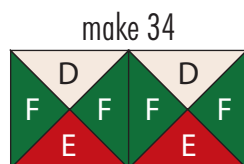

5. Sew one side strip to each side of one  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to make one G block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make seventeen G blocks total.

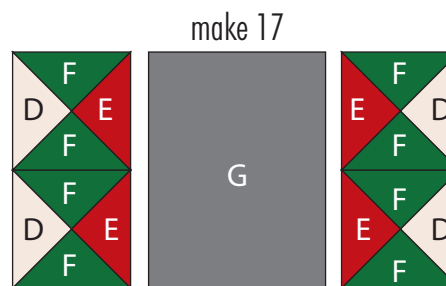

6. Sew  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square, one sashing block, one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, one sashing block, one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, one sashing block and one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square together end to end and in that order to make the Top border. Repeat to make the Bottom border.
7. Sew one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, one G block, one  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square, one G block, one  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square, one G block and one  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order to make one sashing row. Repeat to make three sashing rows total.

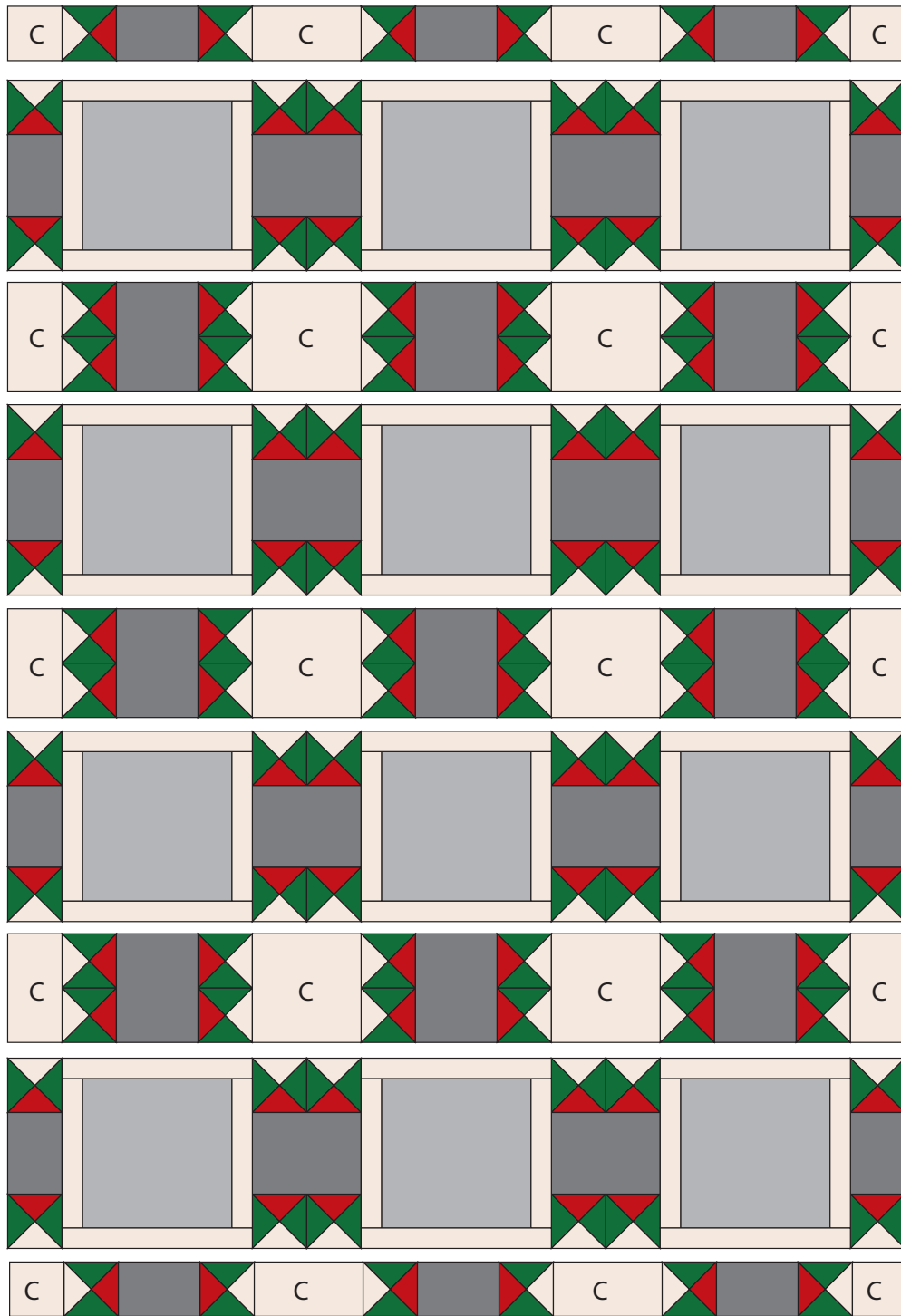
### Quilt Assembly:

(Refer to the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew one sashing strip, one A block, one G block, one A block, one G block, one A block and one sashing strip together lengthwise and in that order to make one Row. Repeat to make four rows total.
9. Sew the Top border, four rows, three sashing rows and Bottom border together to make the quilt top.

### Finishing:

10. Layer quilt top, batting and backing; baste, quilt as desired. Trim layers even with quilt top.
11. Sew the eighty  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half, lengthwise with wrong sides together, and press.
12. Bind as desired.
