1 Daydreamer Panel - 30172 E
5/8 Yard Sashing - 30176 H
1/2 Yard Outer Border - 30176 E
3/8 Yard Binding - 30177 E
1-1/2 Yard Backing - 30173 Q
Light Quilt Batting 42 x 52

 If embroidery is going to be done on this project, I like to stabilize the back as noted on the panel. I cut panel in four sections and did my stitching following the stitching instructions on the panel. After all embroidery is done, follow directions below.

Fabric Cutting Instructions:

Following quilt layout with **letters** noting the panel blocks, **numbers** noting the sashing strips, and **measurements** labeling the outer border strips, cut the following blocks and strips:

- Blocks A, B, D, E, F, J, K, and M center carefully and cut **6-1/2 x 6-1/2 inches**.
- Blocks C, G, I, and L center carefully and cut **6-1/2 x 13-1/2 inches**.
- Block H center carefully and cut **13-1/2 x 13-1/2 inches**.
- Blocks N and O center carefully and cut **3-1/2 inches x 6-1/2 inches**.

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Cutting Strips for Sashing:

From sashing fabric cut 8 strips **1-1/2 inches** wide. Sub-cut into the following lengths:

Cut 2 (number 6 on layout) **34-1/2 inches**.

Cut 2 (number 5 on layout) **29-1/2 inches**.

Cut 2 (number 4 on layout) **27-1/2 inches**.

Cut 2 (number 3 on layout) **20-1/2 inches**.

Cut 1 (number 2 on layout) **13-1/2 inches**.

Cut 7 (number 1 on layout) **6-1/2 inches**.

Cutting Strips for Outer Border:

From outer border fabric cut 4 strips **3-1/2 inches** wide. Sub-cut into the following lengths:

Cut 1 for right side border **36-1/2 inches**.

Cut 1 for left side border **30-1/2 inches**.

Cut 1 for top border **35-1/2 inches**.

Cut 1 for bottom border **29-1/2 inches**.




Assembly Instructions:

1. Top 1st row: Sew sashing 1 to the right side of block A and B. Sew A and B together. Next, join to block C on left side. Press this row open. Set aside.
2. 2nd row: Sew sashing 1 to the right side of blocks D and E. Sew D and E together. Next, join to block F on left side. Press this short row open. Set aside.
3. 3rd row: Sew sashing 2 to right side of block G. Sew block G to block H on left side. Press this short row open.
4. Joining 2nd and 3rd short rows: Sew sashing 3 to the bottom edge of short 2nd row. Next, sew 2nd row with sashing to top of short 3rd row. Press this combination of rows open. Set aside.
5. Right side of 2nd and 3rd rows: Sew sashing 1 to the top of block J. Next, Join block J to block I at the bottom edge. Press open. Sew sashing 3 to the left side of block J and I combination. Press open. Set aside.
6. Bottom 4th row: Sew sashing 1 to the right side of block K and L. Sew Block K to L along left side of L. Next, sew block M to L on left side. Press this row open.
7. Sew sashing 4 to the bottom of 1st row (blocks A,B, C). Press open. Sew sashing 4 to the top of 4th row (blocks K, L, M). Press open.
8. Joining the rows: Sew 1st row with sashing to the top of combo group row 2 and 3. Sew 4th row with sashing to the bottom of combo group 2 and 3. Press open.
9. Sew sashings 6 to the sides of all rows sewn together. Press open.
10. Sew sashings 5 to the top and bottom of all rows sewn together. Press open.
11. Outer Borders: Sew block N to left outer border along bottom of N. Press open.

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Assembly Instructions (con't)

12. Sew right side of outer border cut 3-1/2 x 36-1/2 to the completed quilt center. Press open.
13. Sew the left side (3-1/2 inch edge) of block O to the outer border cut 3-1/2 x 29-1/2. Press open. Sew this outer border to the bottom of completed quilt center. Press open.
14. Last piece, sew outer border cut 3-1/2 x 35-1/2 to the top of completed quilt center. Press open.
15. Quilt as desired and bind. Done!
