We recommend that you carefully read through all instructions before getting started on your project.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS FOR 1 BLOCK

Fabric A, cut:

- (2) 5½" squares for top and bottom.

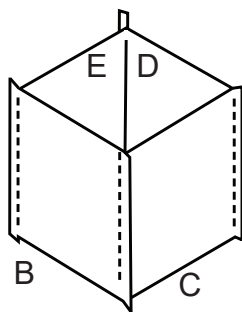
Fabrics B–E, cut:

- (1) 5½" square of each for sides.

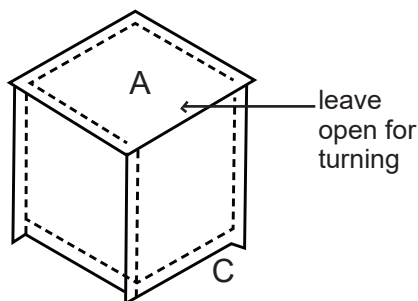
BLOCK ASSEMBLY

Use a ¼" seam allowance for all stitching. Secure stitching when starting and stopping stitching.

1. With right sides together, stitch sides pieces together, starting and stopping stitching ¼" from the ends of each seam. Press seams in one direction.



2. Stitch the top square to the top of the block on 4 sides, 1 side at a time, starting and stopping the stitching at the side seams. Stitch the bottom square to 3 sides only. Press seams toward sides of block.



3. Turn the block right side out and stuff firmly.
4. Hand-stitch the opening closed.

BLOCK 2, 3, OR MORE!

Repeat steps for block assembly with desired fabrics.

--> **Appliqué letters on each side to help teach the alphabet!**

--> **Make a block for every special occasion during baby's first year as a keepsake!**
