


We recommend that you carefully read through all instructions before getting started on your project.

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Note:
WOF=Width of fabric (from selvage to selvage)
Fabric A, cut

- (1) $63 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
- (1) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.

Fabric B, cut

- (1) $63 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip.
- (1) $33 / 8$ " x WOF strip.
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " xWOF strip.

Subcut (4) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 11 / 4$ " squares.
Fabric C, cut

- (1) $63 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
- (1) $33 / 8$ " $\times$ WOF strip.

Fabric D, cut

- (1) $63 / 8$ " $\times$ WOF strip.
- (1) $33 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip.
- (1) 2" xWOF strip.

Subcut (4) 2" x 2" squares.
Fabric E, cut

- (8) $15 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips.

Fabric F, cut

- (32) $1 \frac{1}{4} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Subcut (5) strips into $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 403 / 4$ strips,
(7) strips into (28) $11 / 4$ " $\times 10$ " rectangles, and
(1) strip into (8) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 41 / 2$ " rectangles.

- (6) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for binding.

Fabric G, cut

- (5) $2^{2 "} \times$ WOF strips.

Fabric H , cut from length of fabric, parallel to the selvage edges:

- (5) $41 / 2$ " $\times$ LOF strips.

Subcut (4) strips into $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 45 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips and
(1) strip into (4) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric I, cut

- (2) 62 " x WOF strips.


## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

All seams are sewn with right sides together, raw edges even and using $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.

## MAKING THE STRIP SETS

1. Make (4) 10 " x WOF strip sets with a $11 / 4$ " Fabric F strip in the center of each with a $33 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ top strip and $63 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ bottom strip in the fabrics shown. Press seams toward the Fabric F strips. Crosscut each strip set into (8) $3^{\prime \prime}$ segments and label.

2. Sewing lengthwise, stitch a $15 / 8^{"}$ Fabric E strip to a $11 / 4$ " Fabric F strip. Press the seam toward the Fabric F strip to make a $23 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip set. Repeat to make a total of (8) strip sets. Cut (4) 10 " segments from each strip set to yield a total of (32) segments.

3. Stitch $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 403 / 4$ " Fabric F strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the Fabric F strips.
4. Stitch together (7) $11 / 4$ " x WOF Fabric F strips end to end to make a long strip. From this long strip, cut (4) $451 / 4$ " and (2) $42 \frac{1}{4} 4^{"}$ lengths. Sew the $42 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ lengths to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the Fabric F strips.
5. Stitch together (5) 2" Fabric G strips end to end to make a long strip. From this long strip, cut (4) $421 / 4$ " strips. Sew (2) strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Sew 2" Fabric D squares to the ends of the remaining Fabric $G$ strips. Sew the pieced border units to the top and bottom of the quilt.
6. Sew (2) of the $451 / 4$ " Fabric F strips cut in step 4 to the left and right sides of the quilt top. Press the seams toward the Fabric F strips.
7. Stitch $41 / 2$ " $\times 451 / 4$ " Fabric H strips to the sides of the quilt top. Press seams toward the strips.
8. Sew $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric $C$ squares and then $11 / 4$ " $\times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $F$ strips to the ends of the remaining $11 / 4 " \times 451 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strips. Press seams toward the Fabric F strips. Stitch the border units to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press seams toward the border units.
9. Stitch $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strips and then $41 / 2$ " Fabric H squares to the ends of the remaining $41 / 2$ " $\times 451 / 4$ " Fabric H strips. Press seams toward the Fabric F strips. Sew the border units to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams toward the border units.

## FINISHING

1. Prepare a 62" $\times 62$ " backing piece. Layer the completed quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Trim edges even.
2. Bind the finished quilt with the $21 / 4$ " Fabric F strips
