## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

WOF = Width of fabric from selvage to selvage
Fabric A

- Trim panel to $301122^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2 "$.


## Fabric B

- Cut (4) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut into
(2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 361 / 2$ " strips and (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 33^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- Cut (6) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for binding.


## Fabric C

- Cut (4) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut into
(2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 39$ " strips and (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 351 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric D

- Cut (4) $13 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Subcut into (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 401 / 2 "$ strips, (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 35 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips, and (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 4$ " rectangles.


## Fabric E

- Cut (5) $13 / 4$ " xWOF strips. Subcut into (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 401 / 2$ " strips, (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 38$ " strips, and (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


## Fabric F

- Cut (5) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Subcut into
(4) $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (2) $41 / 4$ " $\times 14^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.


## Fabric G

- Cut (2) 54 " $\times$ WOF pieces for backing.


## INSTRUCTIONS

Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance throughout.

1. Sew (1) $13 / 4$ " $\times 40 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric $\boldsymbol{D}$ strip to
(1) $13 / 4$ " $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\boldsymbol{D}$ rectangle to make
(1) $13 / 4$ " $\times 44$ " Fabric $\boldsymbol{D}$ strip. Make 2 units.
2. Sew (1) $13 / 4$ " $\times 401 / 2$ " Fabric $\boldsymbol{E}$ strip to
(1) $13 / 44^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\boldsymbol{E}$ rectangle to make
(1) $13 / 4$ " $\times 461^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric $E$ strip. Make 2 units.
3. Sew (1) $41 / 4$ " $\times 401 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to
(1) $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 14^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\boldsymbol{F}$ rectangle to make
(1) $4 \frac{1}{1} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 54$ " Fabric $F$ strip. Make 2 units.
4. Sew (2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 38$ " Fabric $\boldsymbol{E}$ strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center, followed by (2) $4 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 46 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $\boldsymbol{E}$ strips to the sides of the quilt center.
5. Sew (2) $411 / 4$ " $\times 401 / 2$ " Fabric $\boldsymbol{F}$ strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center, followed by (2) 4¼" $\times 54$ "
Fabric $\boldsymbol{F}$ strips to the sides of the quilt center.


## FINISHING

1. Sew (2) $54 " \times$ WOF Fabric $\boldsymbol{G}$ pieces together along their 54 " length to make backing.
2. Layer backing, batting, and quilt top; baste.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Make double-fold binding using the $21 / 4$ " wide Fabric $\boldsymbol{B}$ strips, and sew the binding to the quilt using your preferred method.
