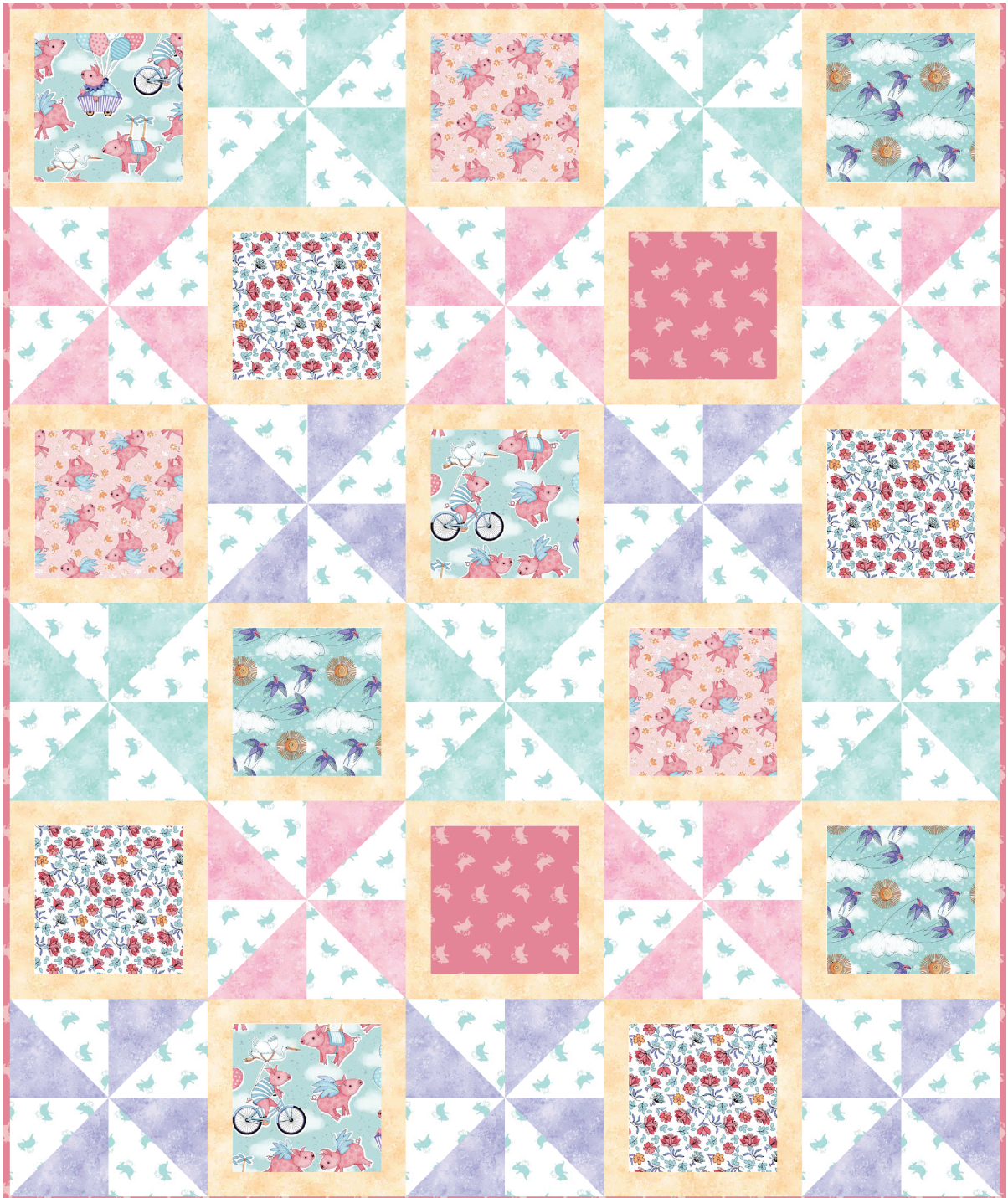
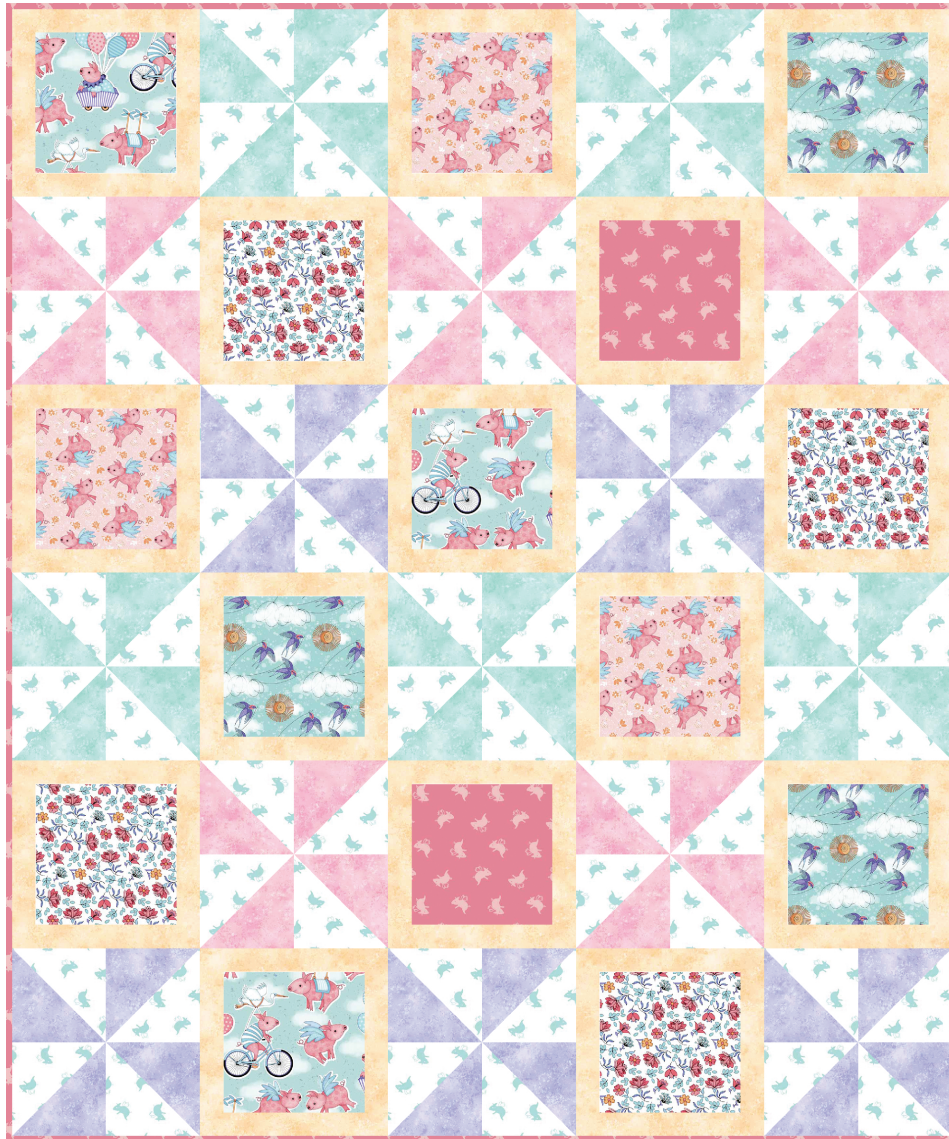

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

**WOF = Width of fabric**

### Fabric A

- one strip 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (3) 6 1/2" squares

### Fabric B

- one strip 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (3) 6 1/2" squares

### Fabric C

- one strip 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (3) 6 1/2" squares

### Fabric D

- one strip 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (4) 6 1/2" squares

### Fabric E

- one strip 6 1/2" x WOF; cut into (2) 6 1/2" squares
- five strips 2 1/2" x WOF (binding)

### Fabric F

- five strips 1 1/2" x WOF; cut into (30) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares
- eight strips 1 1/2" x WOF; cut into (30) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" squares

### Fabric G

- four strips 4 7/8" x WOF; cut into (30) 4 7/8" squares

### Fabric H

- two strips 4 7/8" x WOF; cut into (10) 4 7/8" squares

### Fabric I

- two strips 4 7/8" x WOF; cut into (10) 4 7/8" squares

### Fabric J

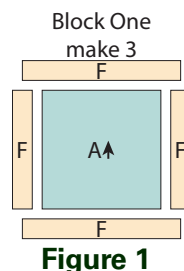
- two strips 4 7/8" x WOF; cut into (10) 4 7/8" squares

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

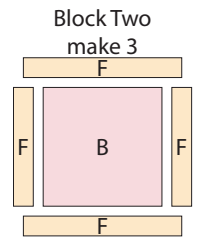
Use a 1/4" seam allowance throughout.

The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

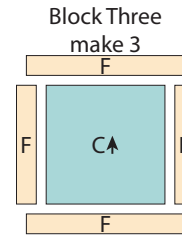
1. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" **Fabric A** square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" **Fabric F** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Fabric A** square to make (1) 8 1/2" **Block One** square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (3) **Block One** squares total.



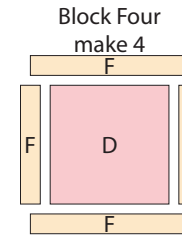
2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to **Figures 2-5** for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) **Block Two** squares, (3) **Block Three** squares, (4) **Block Four** squares and (2) **Block Five** squares.



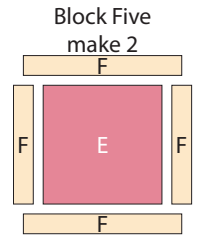

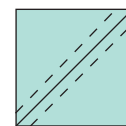

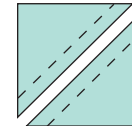

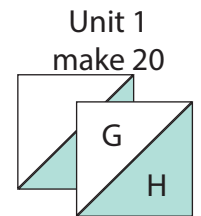
3. Place (1) 4 7/8" **Fabric H** square on top of (1) 4 7/8" **Fabric G** square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 6). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 6). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 7) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 1/2" square to make (2) **Unit 1** squares (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (20) **Unit 1** squares total.

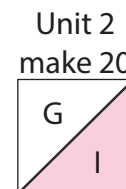

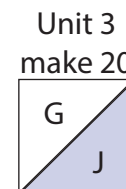

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to **Figures 9-10** for fabric identification and placement to make (20) **Unit 2** squares and (20) **Unit 3** squares.

5. Sew together (4) **Unit 1** squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 8 1/2" **Block Six** square (**Fig. 11**). Repeat to make (5) **Block Six** squares total.

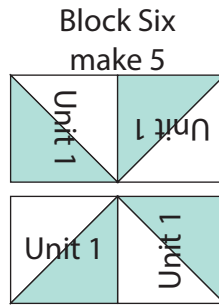

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to **Figures 12-13** for component identification, placement and orientation to make (5) **Block Seven** squares and (5) **Block Eight** squares.

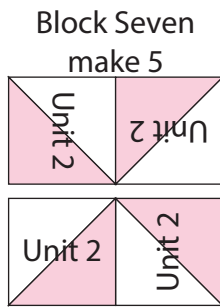

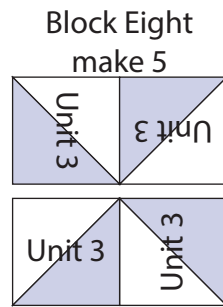

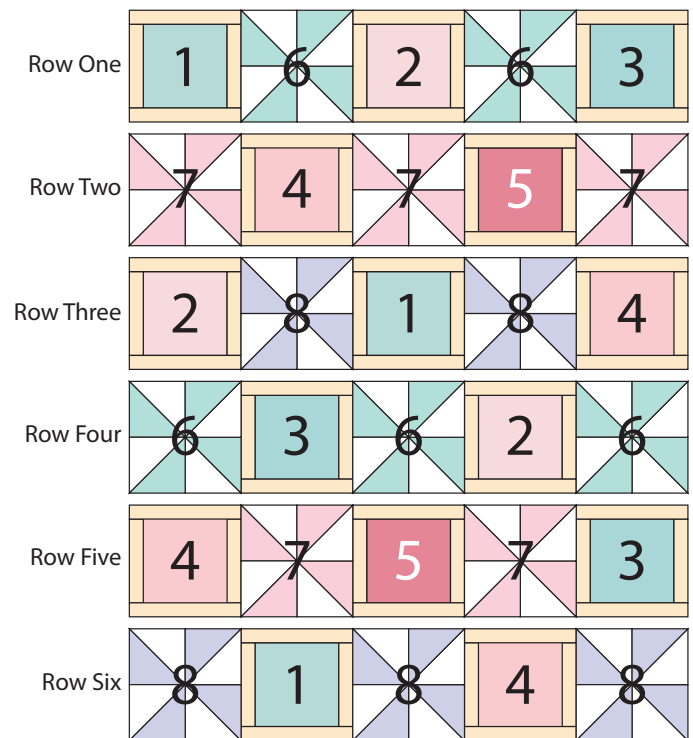
Refer to Quilt Layout while assembling.

7. Sew together (1) **Block One** square, (1) **Block Six** square, (1) **Block Two** square, (1) **Block Six** square and (1) **Block Three** square, in that order from left to right, to make **Row One**.

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to the quilt layout for component identification, placement and orientation to make **Row Two** through **Row Six**.

9. Sew together the (6) pieced **Rows**, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make the quilt top.

10. Prepare a 48" x 56" backing piece. Layer, quilt and bind, using **Fabric E** binding strips and your favorite method, to complete the quilt.
