







Panel Plaid Quilt

We recommend that you carefully read through all instructions before getting started on your project. Select 2 different-width strips from 2 different fabrics. Stitch lengthwise together. Press.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

WOF = width of fabric from selvage to selvage. Fabrics A–F may include any of the following: ²/₃ or 1 yard panel, 1 yard border stripe, 1 yard print or 1 yard basic.

Fabric A-F, cut each as follows:

- 1 set of WOF strips with 1 each of the following widths: 3", 2¾", 2½", 2¼", 2", 1¾", 1½", 1¼" and 1".
- As much of a second set of WOF strips as possible, cutting in the same width order as the previous step.

Fabric G, cut:

- (16) 1" x WOF strips for sashing.
- (10) 1" x WOF strips for borders.

Fabric H, cut:

- 2¼" x WOF strip.
 Subcut into (16) 2¼" squares for sashing and border corners.
- (8) 11/4" x WOF strips for sashing.
- (5) 11/4" x WOF strips for borders.
- (6) 21/4" x WOF strips for binding.

Backing fabric, cut:


- (2) 56" x WOF pieces OR
- (2) 68" x WOF pieces for directional fabric.

PANEL PLAID BLOCKS & SASHING UNITS

Use a ¼" seam allowance for all stitching. Press all seams to 1 side or as directed.


1. Place all **Fabrics A-F** strips in a pile and mix up.

2. Select 2 different-width strips from 2 different fabrics. Stitch lengthwise together. Press. Select another strip and stitch lengthwise to the pieced section. Press. Continue to add strips to make a strip set approximately 24" x WOF. Repeat to make enough strip sets to use all the cut strips.




Make Strip Sets

3. Crosscut the strip sets into sets with 1 pieced strip in each of the following widths: 3", 2¾", 2½", 2¼", 2", 1¾", 1½" and 1¼". For the end of each strip set, cut a 3" strip and then continue in order to use the rest of the strip set.



Cut Sets of Pieced Strips


4. Select 2 different-width pieced strips. Stitch lengthwise together. Press. Continue to add pieced strips to make a pieced section approximately 24" x 24". Repeat to make 5 pieced sections.

5. Cut (4) 101/2" x 101/2" blocks from each pieced section to make a total of 20 blocks.


6. Stitch a 1¼" x WOF *Fabric H* strip lengthwise between (2) 1" x WOF Fabric G strips to make a 21/4" x WOF strip set. Press seams toward the center strip. Repeat to make 8 strip sets. Crosscut the strip sets into (31) 101/2" sashing units.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the exploded quilt diagram as needed throughout the following steps.

- 1. Sew 4 blocks alternately together with 3 sashing units to make a 10½" x 45¾" block row. Press seams toward the blocks. Repeat to make 5 rows.
- 2. Stitch 3 Fabric H 21/4" squares alternately together with 4 sashing units to make a 21/4" x 453/4" sashing row. Press seams toward the squares. Repeat to make 4 sashing rows.
- 3. Sew the block rows alternately together with the sashing rows to complete the 45\%" x 57\%" guilt center. Press seams toward the sashing rows.
- 4. Stitch the *Fabric H* 1¼" x WOF border strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Cut into 2 strips each 57½" and 45¾". Repeat with the Fabric G 1" x WOF border strips, cutting 4 strips each 57½" and 45¾".
- 5. Sew a *Fabric H* 57½" strip lengthwise between 2 **Fabric G** 57½" strips to make a 2¼" x 57½" side strip. Press seams toward the center strip. Repeat to make a second side strip. Repeat with 45%" strips to make (2) 21/4" x 453/4" top/bottom strips.
- **6.** Stitch the side strips to the long sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the strips. Sew a **Fabric H** 21/4" square to each end of the top/bottom strips. Press seams toward the strips. Stitch the strips to the top and bottom to complete the top. Press seams toward the strips.

FINISHING

- 1. Remove the selvage edges from the backing pieces. Join on the long edges with a 1/2" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 56" x 68" backing piece.
- 2. Layer the backing, a 56" x 68" batting piece and the top. Pin or baste to hold.
- 3. Quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the top.
- 4. Make double-fold binding using the Fabric H binding strips. Bind the edges of the quilt using your preferred method to complete the guilt.
