

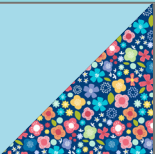
# Minky Cube Pouf

### Additional Supplies:

BEAN BAG FILLER, POLY PELLETS OR FOAM FOR STUFFING

*We recommend that you carefully read through all instructions before getting started on your project.*

## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

**WOF = Width of fabric**

### Fabric A

- Cut (1) 19" x WOF strip. Recut strip into (2) 19" top and bottom squares.

### Fabrics B and C

- Cut (1) 19" x WOF strip each fabric. Recut strips into (2) 19" side square each fabric.

## COMPLETING THE CUBE POUF

**Use a ½" seam allowance for all stitching.**

**Secure stitching when starting and ending seams.**

**Refer to Tips for Sewing with Minky for all steps.**

1. With right sides together, stitch Fabrics B and C side squares together to make an open-ended box, starting and ending stitching ½" from each end of each seam.

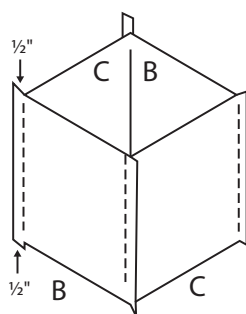

2. Stitch the top square to the top of the open-ended box on 4 sides, 1 side at a time, starting and ending the stitching at the side seams.

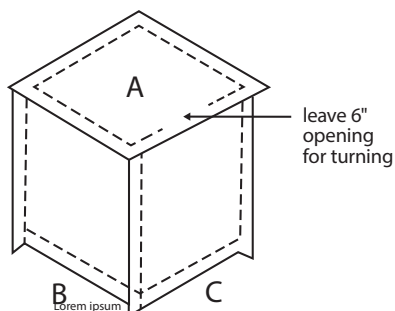

3. Stitch on the bottom square, leaving a 6" opening on 1 side for turning right side out.

4. Turn the cube right side out and stuff firmly.

5. Hand-stitch the opening closed to finish 1 cube.

## TIPS FOR SEWING WITH MINKY

Minky is a stretch fabric with a nap. It is usually 60" wide. It requires special handling when cutting or sewing. The following is a list of some tips to follow when using Minky fabric. Search online for more detailed tips.

1. Use polyester thread.
2. Insert a ball point or 90/14 needle in your sewing machine.
3. Attach a walking foot on your sewing machine.
4. Increase stitch length to 3.5 or 4.
5. Loosen tension a little and test stitching on a small sample. Adjust as necessary.
6. When placing 2 layers together for sewing, smooth with your hands and generously pin to hold the layers in place. In addition, basting spray may be used to help keep layers from sliding during sewing.
7. Pin edges to be sewn together every inch and remove pins as you sew.
8. When sewing a seam, use at least a ½" seam allowance.
9. Do not iron Minky because it will melt.
