## CUTTING DIRECTIONS

## Note:

WOF=Width of fabric (from selvage to selvage)
Fabric A, cut

- (8) $91 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Subcut 48 Background pieces as shown in
Cutting Diagram 1.

- (2) $31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Subcut 24 Quarter Circles as shown in Cutting Diagram 2.
Fabric B, cut
-(7) $21 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF strips for binding.

- (2) $31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips.

Subcut 24 Quarter Circles as shown in
Cutting Diagram 2.
Fabric C, cut

- Cut (3) 57/8" strips.

Subcut 31 Wedges as shown in Cutting Diagram 3.
Fabric D-J, cut

- Cut (2) $57 / 8$ " strips from each fabric.

Subcut a total of 113 Wedges as shown in Cutting Diagram 3.
Backing, cut

- (2) 56 " $\times$ WOF pieces.

1. To piece 1 Circle block, select 12 assorted wedges,

4 Fabric $\boldsymbol{A}$ background pieces and 4 same-fabric quarter circles. Join 3 wedges to make an arc as shown. Press seams to 1 side. Make 4 arcs.

2. Fold a background piece and an arc in half and make a mark in the seam allowances to mark the centers. With right sides together, pin the background piece to the pieced arc in the center and at each end. Sew the background piece to the arc, aligning the raw edges as you sew. Press seam toward the arc. Make 4 arc units.

3. In the same manner, sew the arc unit to a quarter circle, matching centers and sewing with the arc unit on top to complete a $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ quarter block. Press seam toward the quarter circle. Make 4 quarter blocks.

4. Join the quarter blocks to make a $171 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 171 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Circle block. Press seams to 1 side.


Circle Block
5. Repeat Steps 1-4 to make a total of 12 Circle blocks, 6 with Fabric A quarter-circle centers and 6 with Fabric B quarter-circle centers.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Lay out the blocks as shown in the cover quilt.
2. Sew the blocks into 4 rows. Press seams in opposite directions from row to row. Join the rows to complete the quilt top. Press seams to 1 side.

## FINISHING

1. Sew the backing pieces together on the long edges with a ½" seam allowance. Press seam open. Trim to make the 59" $\times 76$ " backing piece.
2. Layer the backing, a 59 " $\times 76$ " batting piece and quilt top; baste. Quilt as desired. Trim edges even.
3. Make Fabric B double-fold binding and sew to the quilt edges using your preferred method.
