



We recommend that you carefully read through all instructions before getting started on your project.

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (perpendicular to the selvages) unless noted otherwise. All seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Fabric A - Green Damask

- Cut twelve $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew seven strips together end to end with diagonal seams; press. From this pieced strip, cut two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 61" strips and two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72" strips. Remaining strips are used to create strip sets.

Fabric B - Aqua Dotted Circles

- Cut five $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut five $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams; press. From this pieced strip, cut three $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric C - Aqua Floral Paisley

- Cut eight $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams; press. From this pieced strip, cut two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70" strips and two $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 80" strips.

Fabric D - Cream Dragonflies

- Cut two $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips; subcut eight $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Fabric E - Blue Dragonflies

- Cut three $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips; subcut twelve $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Fabric F - Purple Chevron

- Cut eight $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for binding.

Fabric G - Green Scroll

- Cut five $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric H - Purple Scroll

- Cut ten $1\frac{1}{4}$ " strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams; press. From this pieced strip, cut six $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- Cut seven $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strips. Sew strips together end to end with diagonal seams; press. From this pieced strip, cut two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58" strips and two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 68" strips.

CONSTRUCTION

Strip Blocks:

1. In order, sew one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strip each of **Fabric A**, **G** and **B**. Press seams toward **Fabric B**. Repeat to make five strip sets.

2. Cut strip sets crosswise into twenty $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip blocks.





Vertical Sashing:

Sew one $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of **Fabric H** to each side of one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $60\frac{1}{2}$ " strip of **Fabric B**. Press toward the **B** strip. Repeat to make three sashing rows.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Refer to quilt image to lay strip set blocks with $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks of **Fabrics D** and **E**. Note that orientation of some strip set blocks reverses. Create four vertical rows.
2. Sew blocks into rows and press seams toward **Fabric D** and **E** blocks.
3. Sew block rows alternately with sashing rows. Press toward the sashing rows.



Borders:

1. Borders are cut with extra length to accommodate mitered borders.
2. Matching centers of strips, sew together one **Fabric H** 1½" x 68" strip, one **Fabric A** 2½" x 72" strip and one **Fabric C** 4½" x 80" strip. Press toward the **C** strip. Repeat to make second side border.
3. With **Fabric H** strip facing quilt, match middle of border set to middle of one side of quilt. Beginning and ending a generous ¼" from edge of quilt, sew borders to quilt. Repeat for other side of quilt.
4. Matching centers of strips, sew together one **Fabric H** 1½" x 58" strip, one **Fabric A** 2½" x 61" strip and one **Fabric C** 4½" x 70" strip. Press toward the **H** strip. Repeat to make second border.
5. With **Fabric H** strip facing quilt, match middle of border set to middle of quilt top. Beginning and ending a generous ¼" from edge of quilt, sew borders to quilt. Repeat for bottom of quilt.
6. Using your preferred method of mitering borders, miter each border corner. Note that because the seams of the top/bottom borders and the side borders were pressed in alternate directions. This should make it easier to match seams in preparation of sewing the mitered seams.

FINISHING THE QUILT

1. Prepare backing and press seams open.
2. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste and quilt as desired.
3. Trim layers even with quilt top.
4. Prepare binding using **Fabric F** 2½" strips. Sew binding to quilt using your preferred method.
